## **Directions**

## From Hartford CT:

(approximately 30 minutes)

Take I-84E to Exit 59 and travel onto I-384E. After 9 miles, this section of highway will end. Bear RIGHT at the fork and continue on RT. 6 (toward Willimantic) for 2.7 miles. Turn LEFT onto SOUTH STREET and continue for 3.4 miles. The Homestead can be found where the road takes a sharp turn to the LEFT.

## From Boston, MA:

(approximately 1 hour 45 minutes)

Take I-90W to I-84 Hartford (Exit 78). After 20 miles, get off at Exit 70 then turn left onto CT-32S and head toward Willington / Willimantic. After travelling 8-10 miles along CT-32, turn RIGHT onto US-275 (Stonehouse Road). Follow this twisting, narrow road until you reach Main Street (RT. 31), COVENTRY. Once in Coventry, cross RT 31 directly onto LAKE STREET As you pass by "Veteran's Green," the name of this small road changes to CROSS STREET. Soon this short section of CROSS STREET ends at SOUTH STREET, where you will turn RIGHT. Follow SOUTH STREET until you reach a small ROTARY. Continue through it to the other side. (You will be entering the rotary at "6 o'clock." Driving counterclockwise, exit the rotary at 11 o'clock.) Nathan Hale Homestead will be ½ mile ahead where SOUTH STREET turns sharply to the RIGHT.
